Two time junior world champion Morgan Krause won the Pro Men division of the 2011 SAWBA Wakeboard Pro Tour.

It was his first win for the season, and sees him top the point's race for the overall South African Pro Tour leader title.

Considered a boat specialist and one of the most technical riders in the game, Morgan, never looked back from the time he left the dock.

While there may not have been any changes to the top podium order, the final did see "Rookie" new comer Dylan Mitchell throw down a big worm which he landed and a 900 which he came so very close to landing. Second place went to Clayton Krause. Matching his rock solid performance from Saturday on the final day, consistently landing his high scoring tricks.

Rookie new comer Dylan Mitchell from Cape Town being rewarded with a third-place finish and local boy Jono Joseph took fourth. Finishing in fifth place, Andrew Bourne from Cape Town and up and coming Liquid Force rider Ryan Durham, followed by Nick Bensch and Kevin Goosen.

The Open Men Division saw Cape Town Cable Rider Craig Eygenberger, who also rides for Liquid Force, earning that top spot with some solid consistent riding all weekend. That not only earned him first place on the podium for Sunday but also puts him at the top for the Tour standings. Second Place went to Midrand Cable rider Justin Mitri followed by Vaal River Local Shaun Meredith.

Gina Faccio and Deidre Van Niekerk would once again be going at it head to head in the ladies division, with Deidre edging Gina out in this one by the narrowest of margins. Candice Bacon (Liquid Force) from Cape Town, placing third.

The Wakeskate division would see Cape Town rider Dylan Mitchell stepping onto that top spot once again, with Mattie Buys not seeming to find an answer to his dominance. Cameron Graham managing to secure third, followed by Jason Morris in fourth.

The Junior Men Division would also see some new faces at the top, Cameron Graham originally a cable rider from Midrand putting together a good enough run and earning him enough points for first, followed by another fellow cable rider from Cape Town François Du Toit and in third place Shane Webster.

The novice division was once again our biggest division. Although we keep seeing the same faces we try not to encourage it. The novice division is there to introduce riders to the competition format, course and judging. It is important that if a rider is to progress they need to be riding in their respective division.
